Get an Explorer-like View on a
Dataset

There is an easy, however not straightforward, method to browse a dataset similar to a ‘Filesystem Explorer’.

- First, query your data via the PSA. Choose the ‘Data Set’ option for the ‘Results Display’
- Second, move your data set of interest into the shopping basket
- Third, within the ‘Shopping Basket’ select your data set and in the confirmation page, select ‘no tar’ files

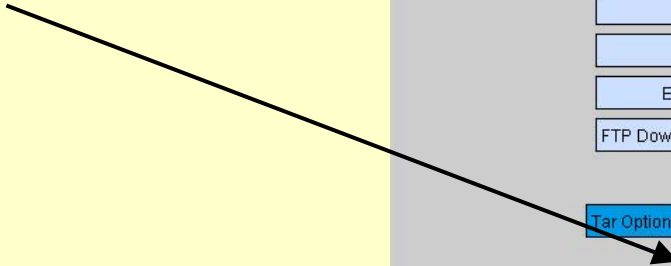

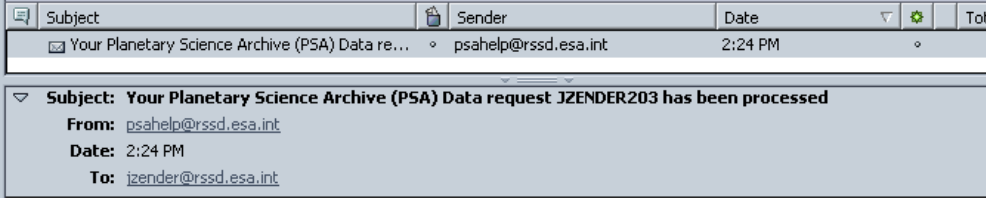
